Official information request regarding leak data for Lower Hutt (our ref: OIA IRO-610).

Thank you for your official information request dated 21 February 2024 requesting the following information under the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (the Act).

- A recent post by Hutt city council states "The amazing crew at Wellington Water have fixed 1,761 leaks in Lower Hutt since 1 July 2023 - with 350 of them since 1 January 2024! "
- Of those 350, how many have had a previous repair in the 6 months prior?
- Of those 350 How many had been repaired more than once?

We have considered your request in accordance with the Act and decided to grant your request in part.

We don't hold the specific data you have requested on previous repairs. Therefore, in accordance with Section 17(e) of the Act, we decline this part of your request because the information does not exist.

We can provide you with a basic revisit rate per year from Hutt City Council leaks instead. Please see this data in the below table.

*A leak reported in the same vicinity of an address that has had a previous leak repaired is normally due to a break on a different section of the same asset. This is not a reflection on the quality of work, but rather an indication of an aging network. Full renewal of the asset will be recommended after multiple reactive maintenance repairs have been required to the same asset.
