Official information request regarding water issues at 19 Curtis Street.

Thank you for your request dated Monday 6 November 2023.

You requested;

- 1. All documents held in relation to historic leak investigations affecting 19 Curtis Street, Karori (including contributing water from 22 Curtis Street);
- 2. All documents relating to "plenty of tests in 2022 to prove that this is groundwater", including the outcomes of those tests and the times at which they were undertaken; and,
- 3. All documents related to the "sound testing on the assets in the area" and any conclusions from this assessment.

We have considered your request in accordance with the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (the Act) and determined that we are able to grant it in part.

Attached in our email to you is the following information:

- Copies of emails between officers requesting our regional water loss team to undertake leak investigations,
- The Kelburn Zone Leak Detection Survey for Curtis Street (which is undertaken by sound testing),
- Job Sheets for 19, 22, 34 and 36 Curtis Street, and, for 2 Putnam Street, and,
- A Eurofins Analytical Report.

For security purposes, the Leak Detection Survey sheet has been password protected and all names and contact details within the provided information have been redacted in accordance with <u>Section 7(2)(a)</u> of the Act to protect privacy.

We cannot provide any additional test results as the information does not exist and decline this part of your request in accordance with <u>Section 17(e)</u> of the Act.

For context, Chlorine Tests are undertaken onsite to determine whether seepage is groundwater or potable water (drinking water) and become unreliable after 30 seconds. All results confirmed groundwater, and this has been communicated to you in previous correspondence.

Please note that our crew have determined that the issues at 22, 34, 36 and 104 Curtis Street have not contributed to the situation you are experiencing, and that the 19 Curtis Street Job sheets follow on from the Job sheets provided in our previous response to you (OIA IRO-325). They have advised that the leaking sluice valve at 2 Putnam Street is unlikely to be contributing to the issue you're experiencing, but our water loss team will assess this issue onsite and make a final call. We will be in touch with you about this.

It does look like ground water seepage possibly due to the prolonged wet weather and with the gradient of the north facing gully water would naturally run across their property. The flow rate doesn't appear to be very high so wouldn't be a high priority however seeing as the issue has been ongoing apparently for 8 months, RWLT should check the 150, lateral/toby and main asset near the address to confirm status.

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We have fixed two known leaks near the property. The video I have attached shows there is a steady flow which was taken 2 days after the latest repair.
