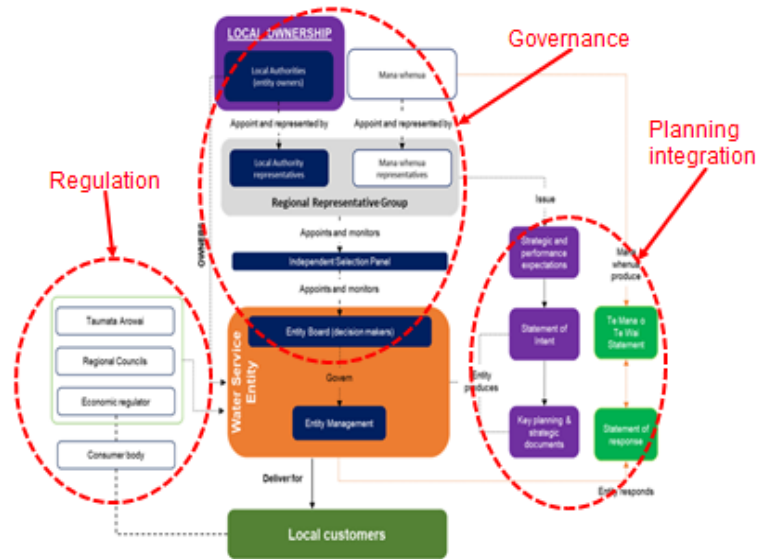
Process update

- Focus has been on the 8 week process to provide feedback to Government on the reforms
- Sharing of information and insights across councils in both Wellington and Entity C area
- Challenging process given not normal council process
- Range of community and council views being expressed
- Feedback due by 1 October
- Process unclear beyond October – awaiting Government decisions
