

With our buffer holding steady above 10%, we're safe to stay at Level 2.

But our rivers levels are still taking time to refill, and it's important we conserve the water stored in the lakes.

This means it's still too early to move to Level 1 - but following Level 2 restrictions will help us get there sooner.





The risk of tighter water restrictions has reduced, but factors like low river levels means a move to Level 1 is still a few weeks away.
