

Life Saving Rule – Moving plant, we must always **wear our seatbelts**

Over the past few weeks we have had multiple Life Saving Rule breaches to do with seatbelts not being worn on moving plant, we thought we needed to clarify the application of this rule, to ensure there are no further breaches.

When we say “we always **wear our seatbelts**” we are referring to any plant/vehicles that has a seatbelt. This includes but is not limited to:

- Forklifts
- Loaders
- Excavators
- Trucks, Utes etc.

6.1.1 SEATBELTS

Seat belts must be worn at all times where fitted.

It also means that the seatbelt needs to be worn at all times and places when you are operating the vehicle/plant whether it is on a road ; on a construction or worksite; depot yard etc..

We need to remember why the Life Saving Rules are in place:

- Failure to comply with these rules can lead to serious and life changing incidents or worse
- They are developed around incidents where the above has happened
