## Official information request regarding information in CCTV Camera's.

Thank you for your official information request dated Wednesday 15 February 2023. On Wednesday 15 March 2023, your request was transferred to us by Greater Wellington Regional Council.

We have considered your request in accordance with the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 and determined that we are able to grant your request in part.

Wellington Water operates 14 CCTV cameras to ensure security of its plants and operations, some of which are Hills and Pelco branded. We are unable to determine all brands used and therefore decline on the grounds of <u>Section 17(f)</u>. Moreover, we do not use cameras for numberplate recognition.

Pursuant to Sections 6(b) and 7(2)(d) we will not be disclosing the location of the cameras.
