Official information request for clarification on response to OIA IRO-269 as well as further information on 18 Creswick Terrace.

I write regarding your official information request dated Wednesday 12 October 2022 for clarification on minimal documentation following scope clarification of OIA IRO-269, for a missing attachment on a Wellington Water letter as well as for additional information on 18 Creswick Terrace from 2002 onwards.

We have considered your request in accordance with the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (the Act) and determined that we are able to grant your request in full.

Please see attached in our email response to you Service Request Data (Pages 1 & 2) as well as the missing Wellington Water letter dated 28 May 2021.

In response to your initial official information request, few documents were provided because that was the only communication between Wellington Water and the owners of 18 Creswick Terrace in the five-year period, we reduced the scope to (from 2017 – to the time we sent our response to you).

Pursuant to Section 7(2)(a) of the Act, some of the information contained within the material provided has been redacted as it contains personal information about private individuals.

Stormwater Investigations - Infrastructure Checks in Your Neighbourhood

Regarding Property: 18 Creswick Terrace, Northland, Wellington

Dear and

Wellington Water is carrying out work to reduce the amount of wastewater getting into the environment.

This can happen when pipes are misconnected, or stormwater enters the wastewater network, overloading the network and contributing to overflows.

You should already have received a letter from us about the work we are doing. This advised that in order to carry out tests for misconnections or other faults, we sometimes need to enter onto private properties to confirm these faults.

During a check at the property above on 06/12/2019, we found a fault or faults that could be contributing to the problem of wastewater overflows. Details are on the following page, along with photographs and suggested ways of fixing common faults.

Could you please have these faults fixed within the next two months. We'll be in touch within this time to check how things are going.

Fault Record and Repair Recommendation/s:

 $1\times$ Low gully trap on a paved area (less than 25mm)

- LETS STORMWATER INTO WASTEWATER NETWORK

Build up the height of the gully trap surround to a minimum height of 25mm on a paved surface (path or driveway etc). This can be done with concrete mortar or by fitting a premade concrete surround and sealing it in place. Wellington Water is aware that premade concrete surrounds can be purchased at Humes and Hynds plumbing suppliers (not currently stocked at DIY stores).
